Dear Friends,

How is it with your soul? The end of the year often draws us to a self-examining mindset. John Wesley, founder of Methodism, was known for asking this question. Christian mindfulness is often underutilized and underappreciated. We tend to either focus on witnessing to others about Jesus or serving others for Christ. In a season filled with lists and activities, what would it look like if we took time to be mindful of the fitness of our soul? It is important to 'contemplate' or be mindful of our personal feelings and spiritual wellbeing. We recently finished a series in worship that centered around "contemplative action". Although it seemed to be to be a kind of oxymoron, without a doubt, our best actions will come out of a more contemplative approach. When we look deeper and are mindful of God's presence in and around us, we will undoubtedly be more effective in our actions.

As we enter Advent on November 27<sup>th</sup>, our focus will be on Reflecting the Sacred. This flows nicely out of our recent series as it begs us to find the sacred or holy in this season and connect to it in such a way that we can meaningfully reflect it to others. I hope you will find a way to participate in worship and mid-week study (if that's possible for you). As I have shifted my preaching style to invite verbal responses from people, I have been intrigued by the responses shared! There are always a few that I expect, but most often there are a few in which people help me to see the scripture or subject in a new light. Hopefully, it has been equally beneficial to others in worship. Each of us experiences life and our Creator in different ways. When we share these unique experiences, our concept of God becomes broader and deeper.

Simply being contemplative on our own, reading scripture and praying, will enhance our faith and awareness of God. For our faith to grow more fully, we need to interact with others while being mindful of the Spirit's presence, allowing God to heal, expand, and form our souls. Then we will find ourselves empowered to do the work to which God calls us, serving others with the light and love of Christ, and being able to declare that it is well with our souls.
